

## Personal Safety Tips

- Avoid walking home alone wherever possible, especially at night.
- Plan your route there and back. Avoid short cuts through unlit areas.
- Let someone know where you are going and when you expect to be home.
- If you think you are being followed, go to the nearest public place and call the Police.
- Do not accept lifts from strangers or unlicensed taxis.
- Walk facing the traffic so a car cannot pull up behind you unnoticed.
- Be aware of your surroundings; an MP3 player or mobile phone may prevent you from hearing traffic or somebody approaching you from behind.
- If you are confronted, run, scream and shout to attract attention.

In an emergency, call 999.
